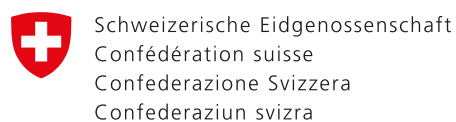

Introduction

Leisure Centre - Domeček Hořovice received a grant from the Partnership Fund to build a maternity center in Hořovice.

Idea of its functioning is based from our teaching experience. In the project we had the opportunity to visit the maternity centers in Switzerland. This visit has affected our view of the problems of working with parents on parental leave and inspired us to change the view of the parent center. Of the visit, we were given practical experiences that we would like to use in our conditions.

Parent Centers in the Czech Republic are established by mothers on maternity leave, which are also involved in their autonomy and the creation of the program. Most they are under the umbrella associations (before civic associations).

In our town will set up a maternity center Leisure Centre - Domeček Hořovice. We are educational organization that provides leisure activities for children, youth and adults. Given the wide range of our organization, we will draw from our teaching experience, we have gained during the implementation of regular, occasional and residential activities for parents and children. Our experience with the target group led us to the decision that we won't establish Nursery, but the Family Center. His name will better reflect the desire to offer a public space not only for mothers but also for fathers, siblings, grandparents, in short for the whole families. The Family Center will be governed by the applicable educational legislation and other standards.

The Family Centre will expand the existing range of activities for the target group of parents and children and will become one of the available forms of the activity by Domeček Hořovice. In the family center will be plenty of room for spontaneous parental involvement, as well as collaboration with community groups around Hořovice.



We Pride The Family Center

Leisure Centre DOMEČEK HOŘOVICE is a town organization whose main task is to ensure the appropriate use of free time to the general public. Until now, we have provided activities for children of preschool and school-age youth and adults. Based on demand, we began to work with parents on parental leave. Apart from the occasional family events and character camp stays for families with children, we began to offer art and hobby groups for parents with children. Mothers with children met at regular meetings, under the guidance of teachers where together with children created. Intuitively, however, we felt it was not enough. It missed the time and space for parental exchange of experience, fun and spontaneous everyday conversation. The Domeček Hořovice didn't have the adequate space, hadn't invented the concept for this target group and activities offered were more random than targeted. The obvious question is what to do.

Project

The project of the Partnership Fund **Exchange of experience and know-how in the field of leisure activities and education for parents with children on maternity and parental leave** has opened up new possibilities. Within the Czech-Swiss cooperation in the project we gained a partner organization Swiss Professional Association of Health Visitors. In September 2013 we visited Swiss colleagues and got a chance to see the system work in practice in Switzerland. In the visits of Swiss organizations we have gained valuable experiences. We got a chance to compare operating system in the Czech Republic with the system in Switzerland, an overview of the identical parts of the system, as well as identify differences. In cooperation with partner organization so we got lots of ideas for activities, methodological support and the ability to implement operating activities in Switzerland to our terms and conditions.

A major contribution was rethinking the needs of parents on maternity and parental leave, which gave our current activities for parents with children in different directions. We found that it is necessary to offer not only regular activities, but also give vent parents themselves within the spontaneous activities and informal education.



An important moment was the fact that so far we match activities to children and not for the parents. We understand the need to support the development of parenting skills and give plenty of space parents themselves. Parents looking for a space where they can meet with their children, and to provide them with not only the conditions for self-realization and mutual sharing of experiences, as well as support and assistance.

The Roofing of the Family Center:

Within the Family Center integration into the organization in the Czech Republic, we selected an umbrella organization Network of Mother Centers o.s, which gave to us the first general idea of the initial organization and operation of a family center in the Czech Republic.

Mission of Network MC

Mothers' Centers Network is an association that brings together members (single parent centers) in order to:

- coordinate, promote and extend the movement MC in the Czech Republic and its participation in international organizations
- strengthen the family value, the role of parents and maternal role of women in society
- promote the legal protection of the family, motherhood and equal opportunities for men and women

Name of the Family Center

As a part of the login process to the Network of Mother Centre, we were asked to name invented for our family center.

We wanted to avoid a name that would evoke a place designed exclusively for small children, so we excluded all diminutive and fairy tale characters. We wanted a name that captures the diversity of supply, variability and coherence.

Because of the Czech-Swiss cooperation on the project, we also reflect on the name that may not be translated.

All conditions fulfilled the name **Family Center Kaleidoscope**.



Family Center Kaleidoscope:

If Kaleidoscope starts to turn, color pieces inside the warehouse begin to change into different colored shapes.

Family Center will be the same variable space. It wants to offer a wide range of activities, gives plenty of room for spontaneous activities, will collaborate with other organizations and offers informal meeting space for all generations.

Our target is that you always see in a Kaleidoscope what exactly you need the most:

- FC as a space where people will spontaneously meet and where they can find new friends.
- FC as an informal space for parents on maternity leave, which promotes self-confidence of parents and acts preventively against the isolation parents from society.
- FC as a safe place for families with children.
- FC as an institution that will offer organized activities, but will also enable activities to implement the principle of family self-help, peer counseling and exchange of experiences.
- FC as an educational and consulting institution.
- FC as a place that promotes voluntary activities of citizens and contributes to the development of civil society. It teaches families appropriate use of leisure and thereby promotes primary prevention of crime.
- FC as the place where can work civic associations from neighborhood of Hořovice that also work with parents and children.
- FC as a meeting place for all generations.
- FC as a safe social environment in which the child finds the possibility of contact with their contemporaries and learns how to see its mother in a different role than at home.
- FC as a place to integrate "different people", which is opens to all races, social classes, people with disability and others.



Primary Prevention in the Family Center Kaleidoscope:

Maternity and Parental Leave

Maternity or parental leave are terms that semantically do not match the reality. Instead of the anticipated rest and relaxation awaits parents more mentally and physically challenging time. Mastering the parental responsibilities and the impact of new, often stressful situations for a young family, can significantly affect the environment, which will offers young parents when they need helping hand. Ideally, close by grandparents, relatives or acquaintances which have parenting experience and can help. Not always are closest at hand. Young families start to stand on their own feet and often move to a new environment what they don't know and where to socialize themselves. Young partners then depend on themselves to mutual support and the ability to orient themselves in a new environment. Parents on maternity leave are threat by following situations:

- Changing of life priority
- Missing contact with the outside
- Loneliness and social isolation
- Own inexperience and helplessness in the role of parents
- Economic problems
- Loss of the professional review
- Discrimination during re-entry into the workforce

Family Center as an Offered Hand

One of the way how to young families easier the time on maternity and parental leave is their involvement to the community in a city or village. Mums and dads are often lacking loyalty to the place with neighbors and other young families. The period of making new contacts may be another frustrating moment. Shyness, specific experience with rejection or discomfort that they actually haven't something to say around because their topics currently revolves around the child, may lead to the development of social isolation. Family centers may be from this point of view a place that can greatly help to young families. Openness of Family Center and meeting space for the spontaneous meetings supports the formation of informal groups, whether by sympathy, self-interests, age of their children, or actual problems and needs of clients. An offer of organized teaching or pediatric activities of the Family Center Responds to their demands. Family Centers are community places not only for informal meetings and exchanges of experiences of clients, but also educational and counseling place for parents in crisis too.



Inspiration in Switzerland

The Family Center KALEIDOSCOPE in Hořovice is created on the basis of bilateral international project. So we have the opportunity to compared options, competencies and work forms of parental and family centers in the Czech Republic with the Swiss model of working with parents and children. The work way of Swiss institutions is In many respects inspirational and helped for us to find the answers to the questions we were asking. The main question was how the family activity center actually grasp. Intuitively, we didn't want to be a "watchdog" parent center, but center open wider public. It most help to us understanding the Swiss targeting for parents and their needs. The view on the Family Center from a different angle integrated our ideas of how the activities and functioning of the center with the requirements of parents. It began to take shape form of the community center in the town, possibilities of closer cooperation with other institutions and non-governmental organizations. We clarified our capabilities and competencies. We began to look around, who can help to us with a family center from the view of ensuring a qualified individual forms of family activities center, so that the impact of family functioning centers in Hořovice in primary prevention as possible.

From the beginning, we were curious about the differences in systems of work in terms of legislative requirements and the scope of activities of family centers in the Czech Republic and Switzerland. The big difference is the actual arrangement of Switzerland, when local cantons (our region) have much greater legislative competence and autonomy than we used in our conditions. Therefore, we asked Mrs. Irene Candido from the partner organization of the Swiss Confederation counselors for motherhood and fatherhood (SVM) for to describing to us the Swiss model work with the target group. From our perspective, it is also difficult to navigate ourselves in the systems of the individual cantons, because we are accustomed to a central state systém management. Therefore, we considered important that this part of the methodology have to work out by a competent person from Switzerland in order to avoid the use of misleading or inaccurate informations.



Preventive Interventions in Switzerland

1st Parental Guidance in Switzerland

The offering parental advice in Switzerland is unique. Virtually in every village or district are for the parents of infants and toddlers available specialist advice. It is close to the parents, is voluntary, credible and generally free.

Parental guidance - now conceived as a profession - is not only concerned with physical development of the child, but also focuses on the environment and conditions in which the child lives.

Whether the child benefits, depends on balanced social ties in which grows up. Parental guidance is therefore nowadays directed to the benefit of the whole family and includes the relationships of parents and siblings. It is opened to all and don't independent of the form of family life and the cultural environment.

Parental guidance focuses on comprehensive health aspect, which includes physical, mental and social indicators of healthy child development, and thus becomes a mainstay for a medical research.

The parental advisor is an expert on the physical, mental and spiritual development of infants and toddlers, breastfeeding, nutrition, care and education. She advises in psychosocial issues, supports mothers and fathers in their parenting role and solve relationship problems within families. She knows the social network and a public offers and may determine whether it should be consulted another expert.

2nd Forms of Services

Parental counseling works on the principle of a crisis center for all parents of infants and children under five years of age. Its basic services include: home visits (the first visit, subsequent visits), telephone counseling, advice on counseling (with or without previous announcement)

Services vary depending on the region and in addition to basic services may include debating groups, courses, meetings and other activities.

Home visits account for approximately 6% of the total basic service offering. It should be mentioned here that are not carried out in all regions of Switzerland. This is especially the initial visit, which will take place shortly after the birth. Other visits are offered with regard to the situation in which the family (multiple births, premature birth, a disabled child, her mother's illness a like)



Telephone advice is available in each advisory space and account for about 12% of the base bid. The times when it is possible to use them is different in different regions. As a rule, however, works from the early morning to the noon. Occasionally it is also available in the evening. In addition to these works specified time answering, that parents have the opportunity to contact the counselor at any time and leave her a message.

Advice on counseling is the most common form of this activity and forms 83% of total services. Virtually every Swiss village or district is established advice, which is open to the public at regular intervals (weekly, fortnightly, monthly). Those interested in counseling is available with or without prior notice. On average, parents visit the advice nine times of one child born.

Thanks to intensive cooperation between our offices with local authorities guardianship is growing number of visits to our employees in high-risk families. The regulation is usually delivered in writing form. The regulation specifically mentioned the required forms of counseling (home visits, counseling in counseling centre), its frequency (weekly, monthly) and the main points, which are a concern (child protection, hygiene, interaction, habits, etc.)

Parents are notified of regulation, as well as about the fact, that the advisor in case of non-cooperation or non-mandated action is required to report this to the guardianship authority.

3rd Contacting

This aspect is different from region to region. Usually, the mother in the hospital signed a statement agreeing to provide the information about the birth of the child to the Consulting Association. In areas, where reporting of birth doesn't go through the hospital, the association receives informations from the Association's register of local municipal office.

After the advisor receives reports of child birth, establishes telephone contact with parents. She offers to parents the visit at their home or informs them about the possibilities of counseling, as well as the opening hours of counseling.

4rd The Focus of Consultancy

The main task of parenting counselors is advising persons who educate child. Topics covered by the guidance touches are varied and always focused on the individual needs of a particular client.



Care

- Tips for parents, how to care for the child adequately its age and development
- Advice on specific care issues
- Advice on health issues
- Support for the care of sick and disabled children

Nutrition

- Tips for parents on how to feed the child properly for its age and development
- Assistance with dietary measures

Breast-feeding

- Sensitization and motivation for breastfeeding
- Mediation of information
- Adequate support, guidance and counseling
- Assistance in normal and aggravated breastfeeding

Development

- Support and sensitization of parents in understanding child behavior at its various stages of development
- Assisting parents in understanding the interaction of relational behavior and needs of the child
- Compression parental intuitive handling with infants and toddlers
- Checks developments in counseling

Education

- Sensitization of parents for physical, mental and spiritual needs of the child
- Support in coping with everyday situations
- Advice on common and simple problems with education

Psychosocial Aspects

- Assistance in overcoming the "normal crises" in the transition to parenthood
- Assist in the process of finding roles
- Identifies relational ability of the family
- Support in understanding and dealing with the needs of families



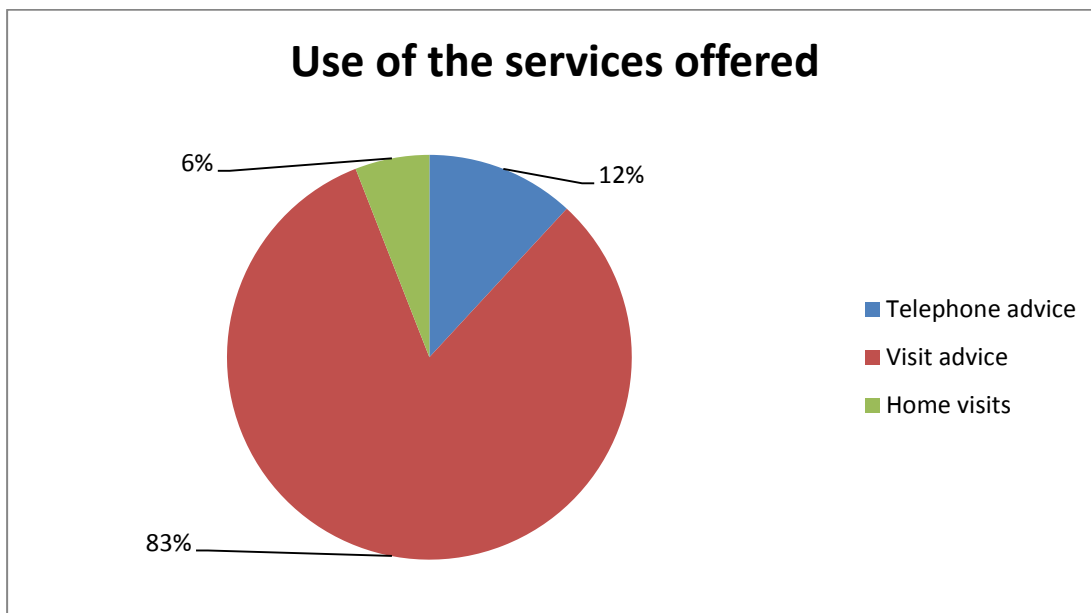
5th Use of the Services Offered (Pro Juventute 2007)

Use the menu

In 2007, the Organisation for Juventute evaluated in the context of far-reaching research a question the use of parent counseling. Pro Juventute is a foundation that has existed in Switzerland since 1912, there has permanent residency and has won quality awards ZEWO.

Under the supervision of the Convention Rights of the Child, the United Nations Pro Juventute committed to meeting the needs of children and youth and enforcement of their rights.

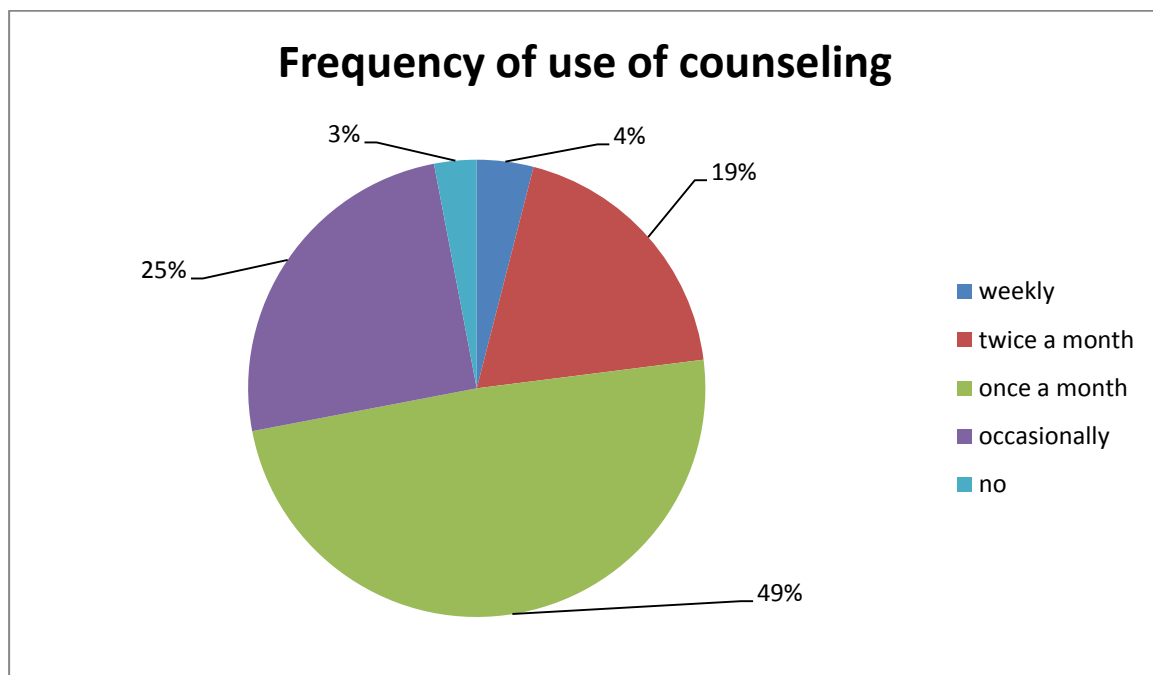
The results of the research showed that parents rely heavily on advice especially in counseling. Depending on the different regional conditions are not all offered home visits, so their share is in the total volume of relatively insignificant. In our region are home visits offered to all parents and about 90% of them are interested. 12% of parents are addressing their requirements through telephone counseling.



Frequency of use of counseling

96% of parent use the advisory services in the first year of child life. At the age of 2-6 years it is still 50% of parents.

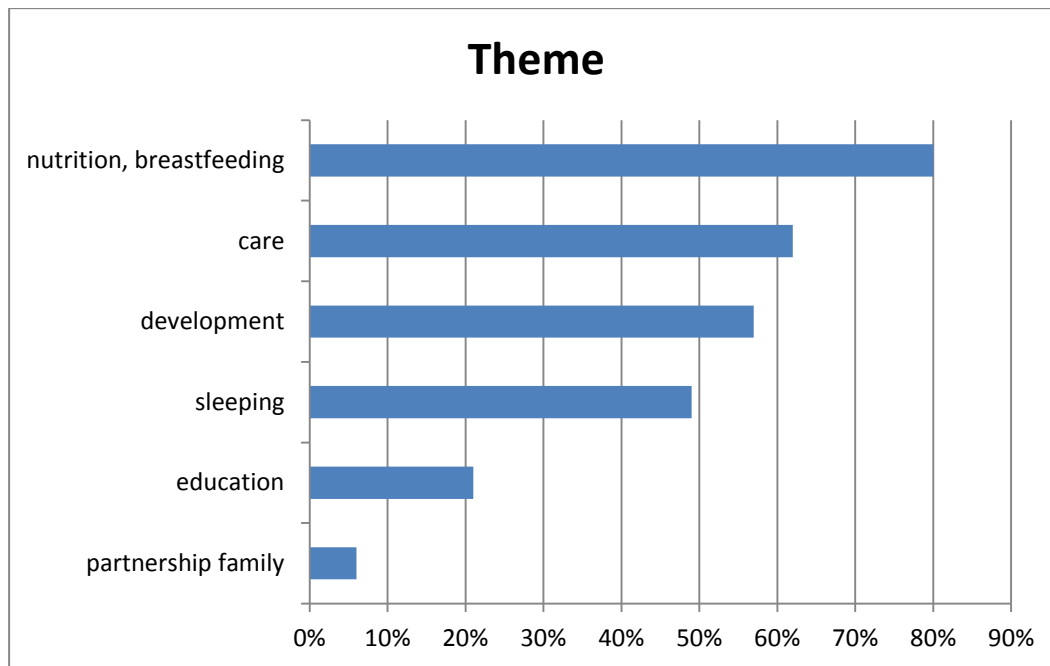
Most of parents show that they usually (in 83% of cases) are a consultancy in counseling.



Parents then appointed the following topics consult with advisors:

- Shouting
- Period of defiance
- Sibling conflicts
- Behavior when children are playing
- Vaccination
- Family planning
- Child custody strangers - return to work
- Diseases of the child / parent illness
- Personal relationships, contacts, housing situation





6th Forms of Organization

Legal status of counseling varies depending on the canton. Consulting works as private legal organizations such as associations, as well as public organizations, which act as the employer community, associations of municipalities or cantons.

7th Financing

Counseling is in most places financed by municipalities in the form of a contribution to his head. Any such contribution is individual and highly dependent on the inclusion of institutions in the health system of a particular canton. In some cantons registration fee is levied at different rates (generally 20 francs).

In many cases, accessing additional subsidy or reimbursement of costs paid by the canton. Other organizations funded through contracts canton of work done.

The salary parenting counselors determined that the employer. In many places in Switzerland, wages are graded according to cantonal wage policy. The tighter the performance consultancy linked to the health system of the canton, the clearer the differentiation of wages, depending on the function.

8th Training

Original name of our profession was nursing infants a nurse and then today we call parenting counselor. Name changes in the range of about one century of history



of female occupations show how over the years, gradually changed the role and concept of the profession. They changed the same time with the family forms and a conceptualization of maternal and paternal role. But this is not changed - parents of infants and toddlers require professional advice tailored to their specific requirements.

Diploma of Higher Vocational Studies in field of parental advisor panel mounting can be obtained by studying the job. To exercise this profession is permitted basic education in health and hospital care DN II, focusing on children's health care or other adequate education. Extension education includes 900 lessons divided into thirteen modules of 60 lessons and a final 120 hours module. Education focuses on how best to prepare future counselors to get through the appropriate tools for practice. It specializes in various areas in basic medical education aren't represented at all, or only partially, and provides the ability to train graduates staged knowledge in practice. At this time ongoing national approval process, allowing close the study of higher professional examination. First steps completed studies are expected in 2018.

9th Association SVM / ASISP (Association of Swiss Fathers and Mothers)

Parental advisors in Switzerland are organized in professional associations parental advisory SVM, which has about 450 members and is attached to the Swiss professional association of nurses SBK. Partner SVM is a Swiss professional association of parental guidance, whose members include employers.



Our Experience with the Swiss System

The unique opportunity to draw inspiration was a visit to Switzerland in the framework of the Partnership Fund in September 2013. Because we were preparing the family center at the very beginning, we have made use of this possibility. Based on the cooperation with the partner organizations of the project ASSOCIATION ADVISOR MOTHERS AND FATHERS (SVM), we carried out a study trip to Zurich.

During the five days we were moving mainly in Zurich and Basel. We visited not only the specific family centers, as well as organizations that are dedicated to staff training centers, social workers and civil servants.

The social system of the Canton of Zürich - City:

Kanton Zürich - the city has its own support structure of families.

Canton has 11 districts and in each is the **CENTRAL OFFICE FOR YOUTH**.

Central Office for Youth

This organization aims to provide social services through their own social isolation and facilitate activities for the family that implemented by local organizations.

Visited Organizations:

Due to the busy schedule we were given an insight into the possibilities of the Swiss system of working with families. We could compare what enables us to our system and legislation and what can inspire to us. Visits to local organizations and centers provided valuable initial comparison of our ideas about the forthcoming center with the functioning organizations in Switzerland. We appreciated the openness of representatives of each organization. We saw not only a successful and efficient activities and projects, but we had the opportunity to discuss about the problems with financing of centers, depending on the local and cantonal social policy, or specific situation of the organization. We could do so quite a fair idea that in Switzerland the impact of financing and state and local policies for activities in the field of socio-pedagogical significant.

Association of Counselors for Mothers and Fathers (SVM)

- Partner organization of the project.
- Umbrella organization of counseling for mothers and fathers.
- Professional organization, the umbrella activity counseling in Switzerland, individual differences counseling based on the government (cantons). From 500 counseling 450 counseling is organized in the framework of SVM.
- Introduction of consultancy and follow-up on the social system.
- Explanation of SMV place in the education system, comparing and naming differences between Domeček Hořovice and SMV.
- Comparison of education workers' organizations and their resulting competence (in the Czech Republic more teacher in Sch social worker with more pediatric education)



Marie Meierhofer Institute (MMI)

- It is the respected professional organization with a great tradition, backed behalf of known child psychologist who has worked in the MMI and was the organization for a long time driving. It deals mainly with the preparation workers (state organizations and associations) who work directly with children or work with children under their control (public administration, social workers, etc.)
- It include among organizations that sponsors, or guarantee a specific project or materials relating to work with parents and children.
- Explanation of work with parents and pre-school children in Switzerland, a practical demonstration of diagnosing a child using video recordings.

Elternbildung in der Schweiz

- Professional organizations what is dealing with education of parents and teachers.
- Demonstration of practical projects and educational and methodological materials for specific projects.
- Bilingualism projects and their usability in the Czech environment.
- Contact the Czech side project STRONG PARENTS, STRONG CHILDREN.
- Clarification of the difference in the view of the objective of education - rather than focusing on the children, but the parents.

Center for the mothers and fathers

- The organization in one of the neighborhoods of Basel, where there is the playing group(preschool)
- Demonstration of operation of the organization - morning program 2-3time a week as part of the preschool, consulting, Treffpunkt (meeting place for parents and children).
- Playing groups (preschool) - Activity are participating children on that this day will come. The combination of regular activity (it is known when preschool regularly opens) and spontaneous activity (come one who wants no entries or applications without prior reservation).

Umbrella Centers for Mothers and Fathers in Basel

- Organization in the heart of Basel, which is home to a network of centers in the canton of Basel city.
- Office space, a place for consulting services - counseling for parents and children and counseling for parents - social activities. It is the social work in families.
- Ones a week works the playing group (preschool)
- Demonstration of operation of the organization - clinic for mothers with children, the telephone counseling.
- Demonstration video diagnostics functioning of the mother and child.



Lola Center

- The organizations in other districts of Basel
- First floor - preschool and clinic for mothers with children.
- Ground floor - Treffpunkt (meeting place).
- Understand the functioning of meeting places - a natural meeting place for neighborhood residents, parents spontaneous activities, relaxing place with food, rents, lecture.

Visit the citycenter Riesbach

- Organizations in Riesbach district, which is a natural and traditional center of the district.
- Broad focus - clinic for mothers and children, preschool, activities for school children, youth and adults. This activity is regular and spontaneous. (similar than Domeček Hořovice)
- Inspection of places and organization - new spaces: Small bazaar children's clothes, the meeting place serves as a restaurant for families with children.

Family Center ELCH

- The organization in the northern part of Zurich, which was opened in 2012.
- Focus - clinic for mothers and children, lending of games and toys, a place for meetings.
- Inspection of places and organization - new spaces, ideal architectural solution leisure organization with a closed yard, hall for physical activities, clubs for different types of activities, meeting place.
- Discussions with head of the center and head of the organizations Elternbildung in der Schweiz.

Organisation PRO JUVENTUTE

- National Foundation Pro Juventute was founded in the year 1912.
- Currently has its headquarters in Zurich, has 26 cantonal branches.
- The best-known activity is **Letters to parents**.

LETTERS TO PARENTS

- Presentation of the activity Letters to parents - regular updates of information (manuals) for first birth women about the progress of their child and situations in the current period is coming of age. The project has a 40-years tradition and is implemented throughout Switzerland.
- It is divided into three parts - for children up to one year, for children 2-3 years old and children 4-6 years. It is accompanied by a special edition (e.g. single guide for grandparents, parents with mental health problems, etc.).
- Given the scope of activities and the fact that local organizations move more in the social and pediatric this project exceeds competences of Domeček Hořovice.
- Its individual parts are a good basis for the creation of a methodology for the specific activity of the parent center.



The Main Differences in Two Countries:

Already, during the first few days, we realized the basic system differences between Switzerland and the Czech Republic.

1st State organization

A main difference is the state organization in Switzerland, where the individual cantons (regions) haven't the same law or social system. We can't generalize the model works in Switzerland and describe the whole of Switzerland, it is necessary to take into account the differences between individual cantons. We moved mainly in the canton of Zürich - City, one day we spent in the canton of Basel.

2nd Education of workers

Another specific difference against the Czech Republic is itself education of family centers workers, their competencies and mission in the family center. In the Czech Republic, the emphasis is on the teaching education staff with children in Switzerland is more focused on the content of education and pediatric advisory area. Compared to the Czech Republic in addition the family center worker must work to satisfy graduate studies and long-term practice in a particular center. Logically, Swiss colleagues are more focused on health and child development, we are more focused on training and mentoring.

3rd Preoccupation with Parents

Understanding Swiss view of the target group has fundamentally changed our view of the possible function of the family center. Proper targeting of activities to parents and cooperation between state and non-state organizations in turn will strengthen the contribution of the family to the town center of Hořovice. Our teaching more focused on child and primary activities targeting children would not bring the necessary development of parenting skills, the importance of family or community center for residents of the city or need a casual environment where they can work together representatives of the community, government and non-governmental organizations in the public and civic initiative. On the contrary, we left to tie the school looking for leisure facilities and use of the possibility that a family center with its openness, flexibility and relative informality of the community can view the town Hořovice bring.

4th Parental Leave

The next big difference is the parental leave. This term does not exist in Switzerland. In Switzerland, they only have the maternity leave, which lasts 14 to 16 weeks. As the title implies, it refers only to mothers. After the expiry of maternity leave they again picked to work.



Determining the Needs of Parents

Total questionnaire was attended by 282 respondents. The questionnaire was completed by 68 respondents, which is 24.11% of the respondents.

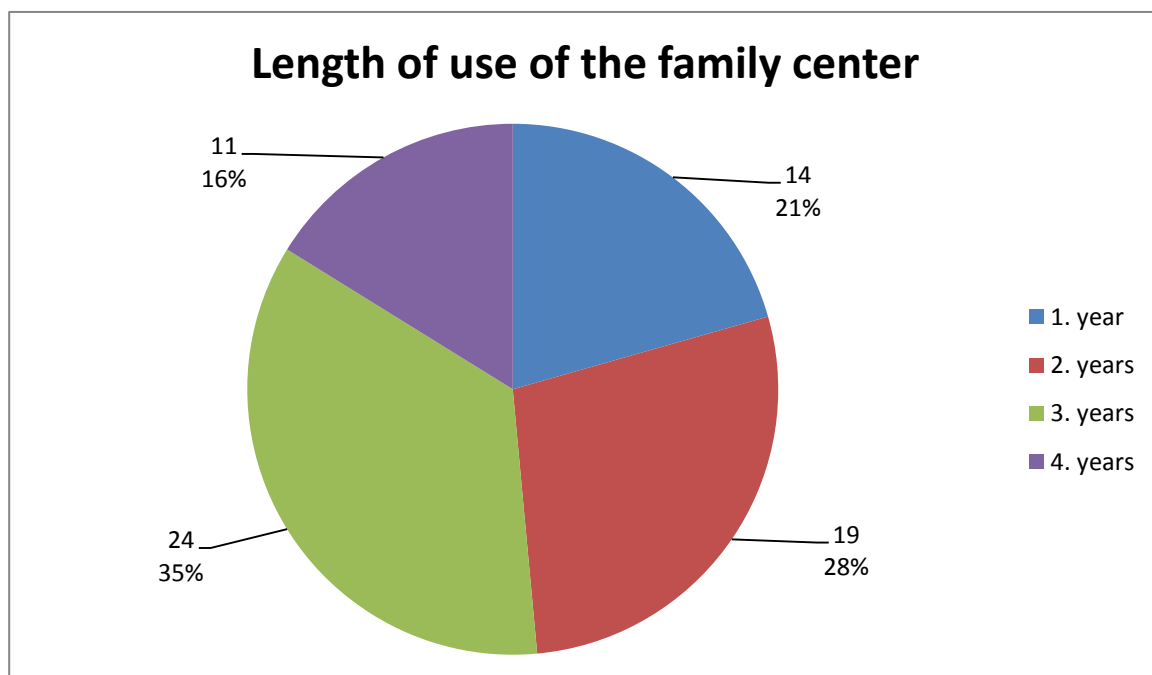

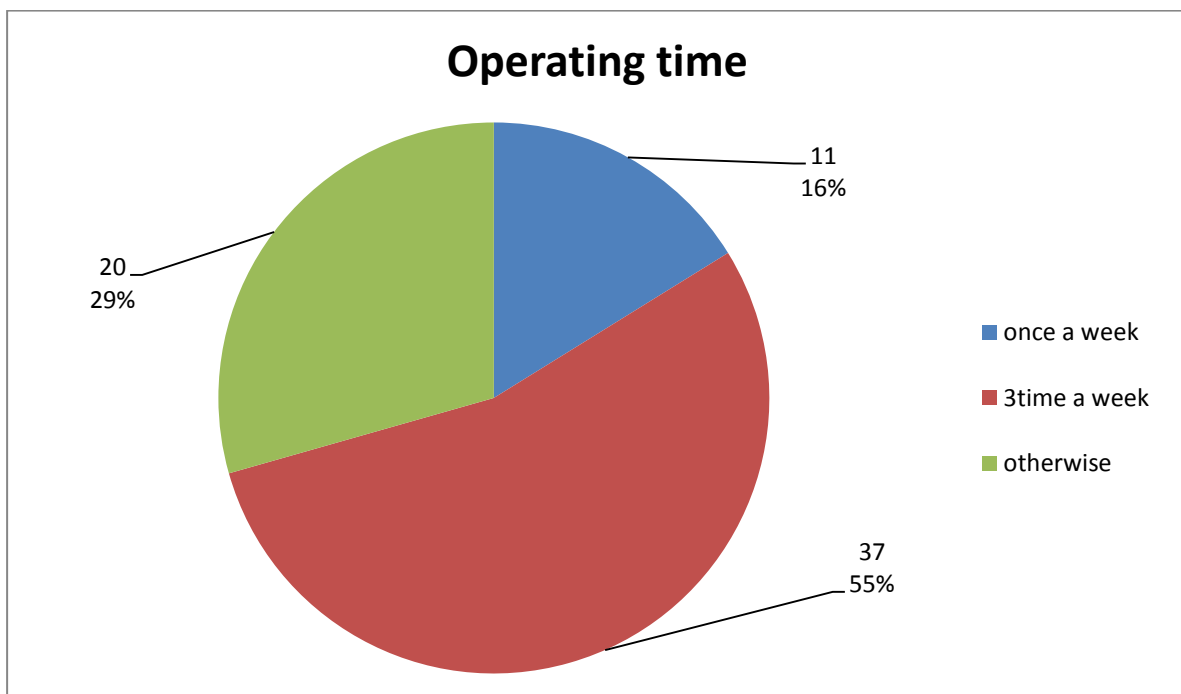

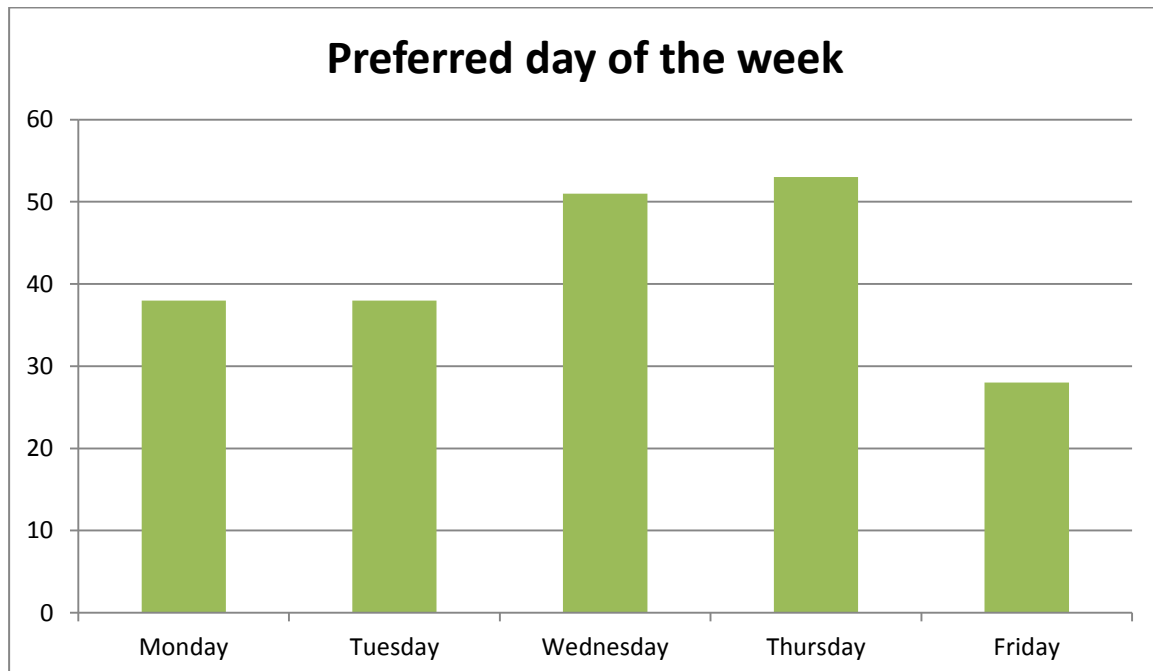

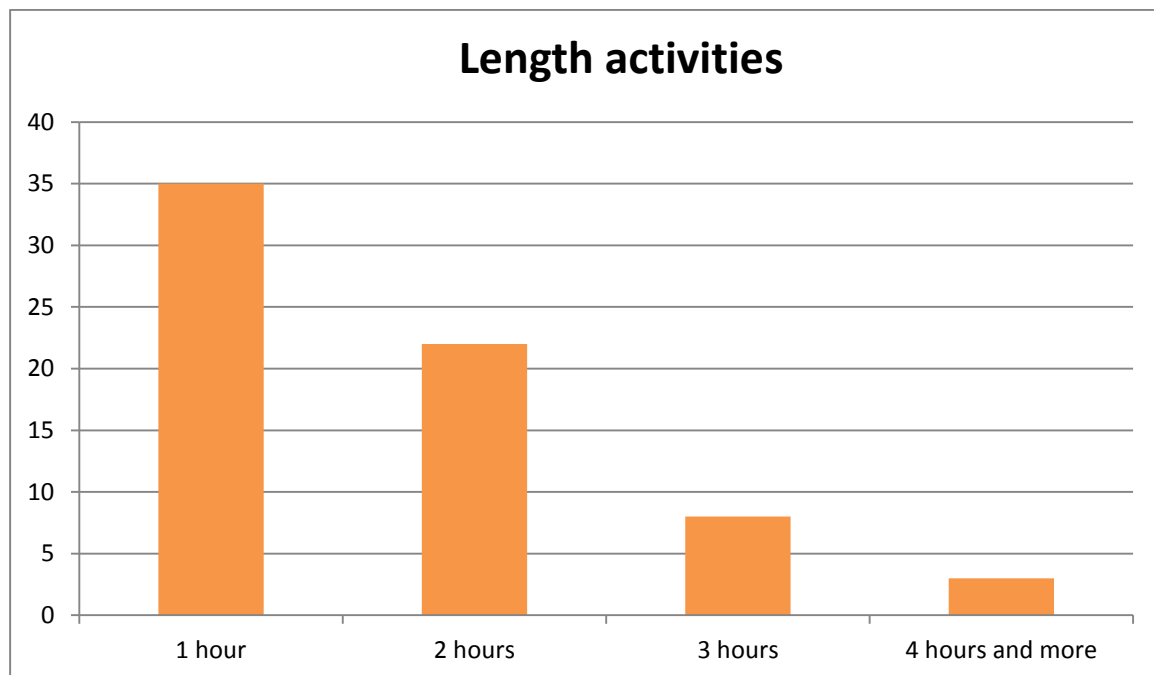

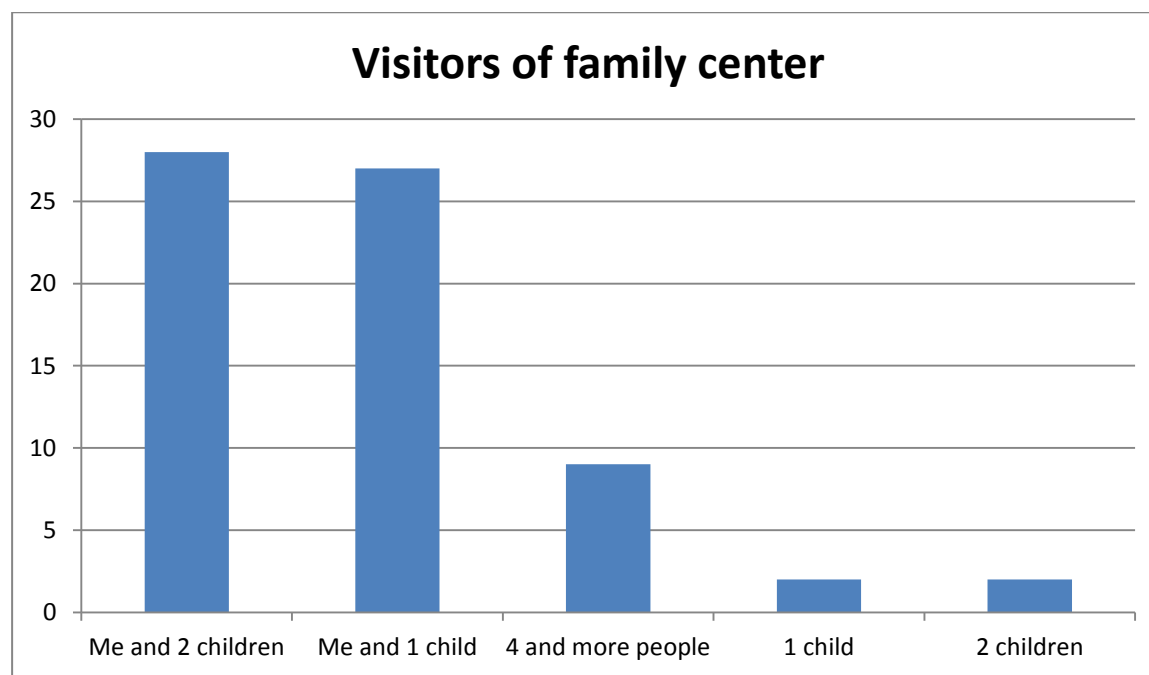

In December 2013 the City Council of Hořovice decided the location of a family center in the old castle. A big plus of this decision is barrier-free space and quiet location.

In the space of the old castle we got three big rooms, lobby and restrooms. Their condition corresponded to the fact that several years have not been used and not in them heated. It was evident that they must be given construction work to meet the requirements for the operation of a family center.

Planned construction work:

- Painting
- Replacement of doors
- New floor coverings

Discussions about areas with Swiss experts

In January 2014, we welcomed in Hořovice Swiss colleague, with whom we discussed in particular about the planned program of the Family Center, usage and editing space and material equipment. In the context of labor negotiations, we appreciated their help in solving the spatial use of the center and its amenities. The specific use of the space we agreed. Due to the fact that all the rooms are interconnecting, we agreed on the spatial arrangement of the family center. From the lobby we make cloakroom with toilet, one room will be equipped as a space for spontaneous meetings and kitchen, another room will be a playroom for children, and the last room will serve as a universal classroom and nursing room. The planned reconstruction casinos we also get one more restrooms with toilets.



Recommendation:

- When painting the interior to choose colors that reflect light
- Create a public family room with refreshments
- Create a playroom for children
- Create a universal classroom
- Replacing the flooring in the playroom and classroom
- Resolve timing covers heating

Material equipment

During negotiations with the Swiss delegation of experts were solved simultaneously with space and material equipment of the center.

Recommendation:

- The interior must be pleasing to both adults and children - overdo it with decorations baby
